- DNS (Domain Name System)




Basic Web Server

- IIS (Internet Information Services)




Server-Side Scripting

- ColdFusion

Client-Side Scripting

Client-side scripts are processed by the client (web browser). This means the programmer has very little control of the environment running the script, resulting in varied user experience.

- JavaScript
- VBScript
 - Limited to Microsoft products like Internet Explorer

Run-time Scripting

Programming run-time applications requires that a compatible run-time environments be installed on the client machine and all code must be compiled each time changes are made.

- Flash (ActionScript)
- Silverlight (.NET)
- Java






Web Services

- XML (Extensible Markup Language)
- SOAP (Simple Object Access Protocol)
- WSDL (Web Service) **Remote Servers** Description Language) **Scripting Server HTTP Server** Database

SOA (Service Oriented Architecture)

a flexible set of design principles used during the phases of systems development and integration. A deployed **SOA-based architecture** will provide a looselyintegrated suite of services that can be used within multiple business domains.



AJAX

- Asynchronous <u>JavaScript and XML</u>
- A method of making HTTP requests without leaving the current page.
- Allows the developer to create very powerful and user friendly applications

CSS

- Cascading Style Sheet
- Used to globally define visual appearance of HTML content.
- Selectors (Elements, IDs, Classes)
- Properties
